INTRODUCTION:

The last lesson examined some of the prayers of Jesus. His prayers revealed both His committed prayer life, as well as His focus to do His Father's will and fulfill His assignment in the Earth.

This lesson examines some of the prayers, and references to prayer in the New Testament epistles(letters).

While we have only one recorded prayer Jesus taught His disciples (the Lord's prayer), there are many references to Jesus praying with and in the presence of the disciples. Those references, and not doubt times that weren't documented taught the disciples much about prayer.

PRAYERS OF THE APOSTLE PAUL

While was not one of the original twelve apostles, he was chosen by the Lord Jesus to be an apostle (Acts chapters 9, 13, 14, and others). God inspired Paul to write half of the New Testament. We will examine some of the prayers found therein.
